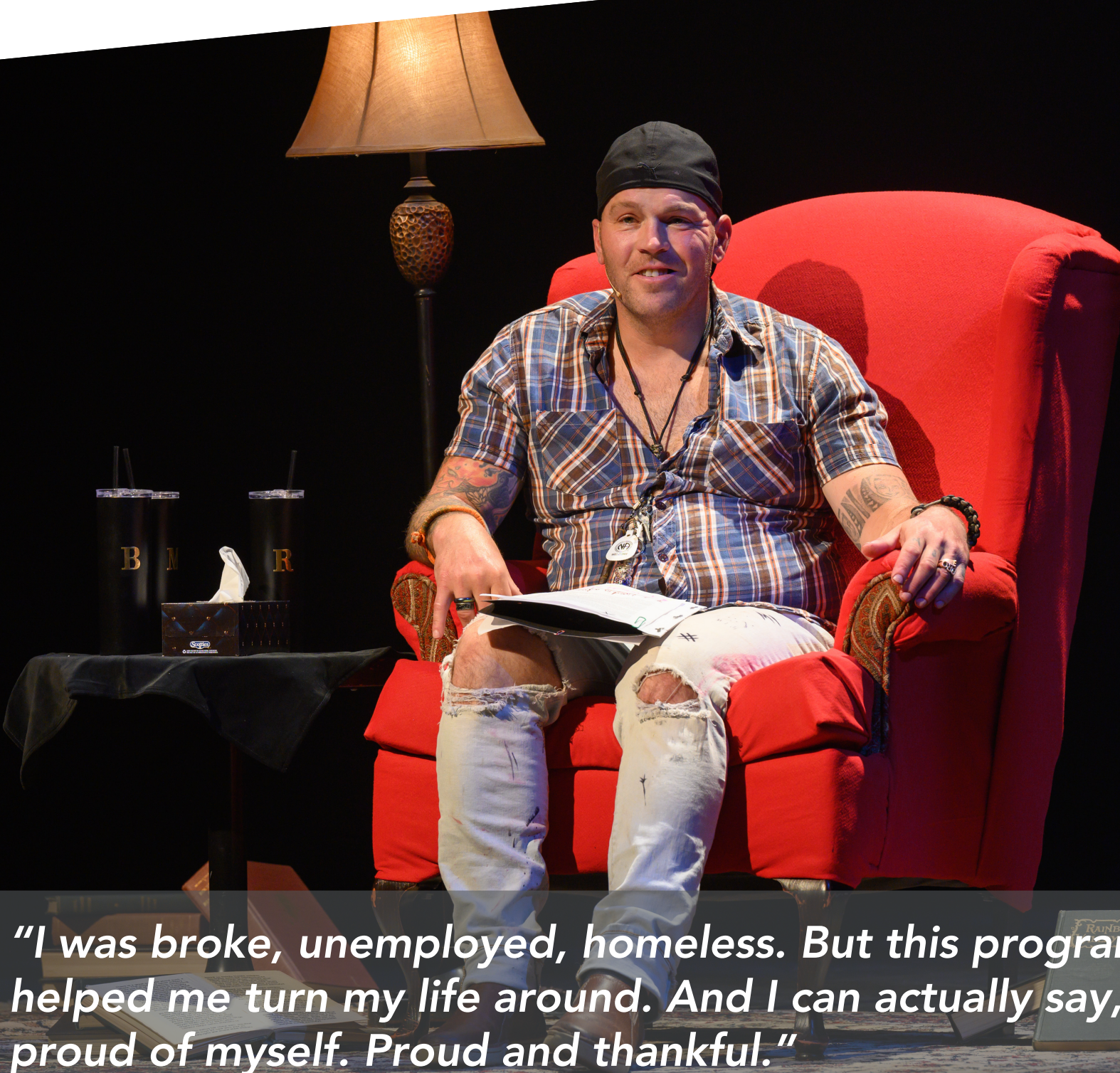


Meet Brendan
